Surrey County Cricket Club: Boys U10-U18 and Girls U13-U18 Assessment Application Process

Introduction

Outlined below is information, terms and conditions that apply to the Boys U10-U18 and Girls U13 to U18 Assessment Application Process, which allows users of the scheme the opportunity to submit video content and personal details to Surrey County Cricket Club (SCCC thereafter), for review by coaches at SCCC, demonstrating their skills as a batter, bowler or wicket-keeper.

Videos submitted will be viewed by SCCC Talent Pathway Staff, who will be assessing each submission based on a range of technical criteria.

Successful applicants will be invited to an 'in-person observation session' on a group basis in the period later in the summer before being informed of further engagement by email.

Unsuccessful applicants receive a generic form of skill-set feedback based on our 'Surrey ID'. This will outline the attributes and characteristics we seek to identify and develop in Surrey Pathway cricketers.

Dates

Entries can be submitted between Friday 1 May 2026 and Monday, 15 June.

Who is Eligible

This scheme is open to players in academic years 5 to 13 (from 1 September 2026) to submit their personal details and video content. All individuals submitting content must have the permission of their parent or guardian.

To qualify to engage in the Surrey CCC Talent Pathway you must either; Live in Surrey/Go to School in Surrey/Be registered at a Cricket Club within Surrey.

You must possess a British Passport, or have Permanent Leave to remain in the United Kingdom.

Current Members of Surrey Talent Pathway age-groups NEED NOT APPLY. These players will be invited to onto winter programmes for the 2026-27 cycle (or not) based on an interpretation of their recent development. Some players may be asked to attend an assessment session before a decision is made on their future involvement.

How to Submit

Submissions must be made via Whatsapp via the details provided:

Boys U10-U18 (school years 5 to 13) – 07539 158159

Girls U13-U18* (school years 8 to 13) – 07539 158154

*For U10-U12 girls, we are launching our new early engagement programme, where we will be running open trials for the 2027 season. Phase 1 of the process will offer in-person trials in July/August across three different venues. Successful players from these trials will be invited to a second trial in September/October 2026.

The receiving devices are owned by SCCC, and the Whatsapp accounts are registered as business accounts.

CALLS TO THESE NUMBERS WILL NOT BE ANSWERED – these numbers are linked to Whatsapp data gathering only.

On completing your submission, you will receive an automated response from SCCC informing you that your submission has been successful. This response will include a consent and data protection form which must be completed to confirm the application.

Use of Video Content, Personal Details and Data

Videos will be reviewed by SCCC coaches on a secure device and server. All SCCC staff reviewing submissions are DBS (Disclosure and Barring Service) checked and safe-guarding training.

Coaches will review submissions during July/August 2026. After this point, successful applicants will be contacted via email informing them of their progression to the next stage in the process, should they wish to continue.

Your Data

To enter this scheme, we require:

- A video of the applicant playing cricket (please watch the instructional video of an explanation of what footage we require)
- Contact email address(es) for a parent/guardian
- First Name, Surname of Player
- Date of Birth of Player

Please note that, to ensure that our selection process is equitable and 'blind' in nature, do not reference club or school affiliation in the video or accompanying text.
