

POMMERY “FESTIVAL OF RED BALL CRICKET” 2026 COMPETITION – FULL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Introduction

These are the rules for the Pommery Champagne giveaway during Surrey County Cricket Club’s Festival of Red Ball Cricket. By participating in the competition, each entrant agrees to be bound by these rules.

2. The prize

The prize is a bottle of Brut Royal Pommery Champagne. No other alternative prize is available, in whole or in part and this prize is non-transferable. The prize will only be provided to the winners from this competition.

3. Competition

The competition will run on Day 1, 2 & 3 of the County Championship fixture between Surrey and Nottinghamshire on Thursday 20th – Saturday 22nd August. Pommery will be running a celebration of Red Ball competition offering fans within the ground the chance to share a selfie of them celebrating the game.

Fans must share a selfie of themselves at the ground and tag Surrey County Cricket Club on either Instagram or x (@surreyccricket). The best photos (which is up to Surrey County Cricket Clubs discretion) will be shown on the big screen with the successful entrants then being drawn at random to win the prize.

Opening and closing dates

For Day 1 (Thursday 20th August), the competition will open from 10:00am and close at 15:00. For Day 2 (Friday, 21st August) the competition will open from 10:00am and close at 15:00. For day 3 (Saturday, 22nd August) the competition will open at 10:00am and close at 15:00.

4. Who can enter?

- a. This competition is only open to people within the ground during the competition
- b. Entrants must be aged 18, or over.
- c. The following are not eligible to participate:
- d. Employees of Surrey County Cricket Club or Pommery;
- e. Other persons assisting with this competition.
- f. There is no alternative method of entry.

5. When will the prize draw happen, and how will the winner be contacted?

- a. For Day 1 the prize draw will happen during the Tea interval of Surrey vs Nottinghamshire and the winner will be contacted by Surrey County Cricket Club and given a time to meet outside the Members Pavilion.
- b. For Day 2 the prize draw will happen during the Tea interval of Surrey vs Nottinghamshire and the winner will be contacted by Surrey County Cricket Club and given a time to meet outside the Members Pavilion.
- c. For Day 3 the prize draw will happen during the Tea interval of Surrey vs Nottinghamshire and the winner will be contacted by Surrey County Cricket Club and given a time to meet outside the Members Pavilion.
- d. If there is no acceptance or acknowledgement from the winner within 1 hour of being contacted Surrey County Cricket Club has the right to withdraw the prize entitlement and to award the prize to an alternative qualifying entrant.
- e. If there are no qualifying entrants Surrey County Cricket Club hold the right to not issue the prize.
- f. The winner must be aged 18, or over, and must be able to prove they are with valid ID.
